Summer Semester Schedule

June 1 - August 28

Church Music: June 1 - 5 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Jeff Pate**, Pastor, Riverwood Presbyterian Church, Tuscaloosa, AL; M. Div. Sangre de Cristo Seminary; B.Ed. in Choral Music, Auburn University; Church Music Director; Former Director of the Wet Mountain Valley Chorale.

A Biblical and historical study of music, and the pastor's responsibility for music in the worship ministry of the church.

The Pastor's Walk: June 8 - 12 (1sem. hr.), **Rev. Benjamin T. Parmer**, Associate Pastor, Brookdale Presbyterian Church, St. Joseph, MO; Director of Operations, International Xchange Org.; M.Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; B.S. Business Management, Samford University; former Dean of Students, Sangre de Cristo Seminary, Missionary to Puerto Rico and Asia; Campus Outreach Ministry, Univ. of Central Florida.

The pastor's union to Jesus Christ, glorying in His cross, fellowship with His church and walking in the Spirit are foundational aspects of ministry. Without a focus on these principles a seminary education may be counterproductive.

Doctrine of Salvation: June 15 - 19 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. Louis Hill**, President, Reformed Discipleship Ministries; Adjunct Professor of Spiritual Life and Theology, New Geneva Theological Seminary; D. Min., M.A.T.S., Reformed Theo. Sem.; M.Ed., Auburn Univ.; B.A., Samford University; Conference Speaker, director of Navigator's small town and rural network.

Students will study Soteriology in order to deepen their understanding of the finished and ongoing work of Christ.

Church History III: June 22 - July 3 (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Tony Felich**, Pastor, Redeemer PCA; D. Arts, Whitefield Seminary; M.Div. Covenant Theological Seminary; B.A. Moody Bible Institute; Soccer Coach and Gardener.

The history of the church will be studied from the Protestant Reformation to the Modern Church.

Pastoral Duties I: July 6 - 10 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. Tony Felich**, See credentials above,
The pastoral responsibilities such as weddings, funerals and visitation, will be studied and practiced.

Pastoral Duties II: July 13 - 17 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Philip S. Kruis**, Pastor, Rincon Mountain Presbyterian Church, Tucson, AZ; Board Member, Providence College; M.Div. and Masters in Marriage and Family Therapy, Reformed Theological Seminary; B.A., Dordt College.
The pastoral administrative responsibilities common to pastors in overseeing the office and business aspects of the local church will be introduced.

Doctrine of the Church: July 20 - 24 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Luke Evans**, Lead Pastor, Christ Church San Antonio, TX; M.Div. Westminster Theological Seminary; B.A., Baylor University.
This course in ecclesiology is a systematic study of the Biblical teachings concerning the Church.

Doctrine of the Sacraments: July 27 -31 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Luke Evans**, See credentials above.
The Biblical and historical teaching of the meaning, means and recipients of the sacraments will be studied.

Apologetics: August 3 - 14 (2 sem. hrs.) **Rev. Matthew Holst**, Pastor, High Plains Fellowship, PCA, Falcon, CO; Instructor in Bible and Theology, Evangelical Christian Academy, Colorado Springs; M.Div., New Geneva Theological Seminary; M.A. in Historical Theology, Westminster Seminary, California.
Students will be introduced to various world views and the discipline of defending the Christian Faith through Scripture.

Biblical Ethics: August 17 - 28 (2 sem. hr.) **Rev. Randy C. Martin**, Pastor, Covenant Presbyterian Church, PCA, Bakersfield; Former Chair Biblical Studies Department, Instructor in Ethics, Bakersfield Christian High School; M.Div., Covenant Theological Seminary; B.A. UCLA; Apologist and Writer.
A study of the Biblical standards for personal and social behavior.

Epistle to the Colossians: June 2 - August 25 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Ryan K. Reynolds:** Dean of Students, Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D.Min. Candidate, Covenant Theological Seminary; D.B.S., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; former Pastor, Redeemer Christian Fellowship, Roswell, N.M.
This is a weekly exegetical study of Colossians with application for today.

Public Worship: June 3 - August 26 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller**, President, Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D.Min., Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary; Th.M. Covenant Theological Seminary; M.Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; B.A. Covenant College; CPE Advanced Status; Pastor, Army Reserve Chaplain (COL) Ret.
This course exposes the student to different models of worship practiced by the summer instructors.

Fall Semester Schedule

September 7 - December 11

Essentials of Old Testament Hebrew: (10 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller**, See credentials above.
Students will learn the basics of Old Testament Hebrew grammar and syntax and begin to translate and study the Old Testament from the Hebrew.

New Testament Survey: (2 sem. hrs.) **Rev. Ryan K. Reynolds,** See credentials above.

In this course students will read the whole New Testament and will cover the background, themes, development and purposes of each book.

Applied Exegesis: (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller.** See credentials above.

*This course trains the students to follow a logical process in preparing sermons and Bible lessons. This was formerly called *The Exegetical, Hermeneutical, Homiletical Process.**

Greek Exegesis: (2 sem. hrs.) Prerequisite: N.T. Greek, **Dr. Dwight Zeller.** Director Emeritus, Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D.Min., Eastern Baptist Theological Seminary; Th.M., Chicago Graduate School of Theology; M.Div., Memphis Theological Seminary; B.A., Bob Jones University; Pastor and Retired Navy Chaplain.

Detailed studies of Old Testament passages will be made from Greek texts.

Hebrew Exegesis: (2 sem. hrs.) Prerequisite: O.T. Hebrew, **Dr. Dwight Zeller.** See credentials above.

Greek and Hebrew Seminar: (2 sem. hrs. each); Prerequisites: O.T. Hebrew and N.T. Greek; **Dr. Dwight Zeller.** See credentials above.

Seniors will prepare and teach sections of New and Old Testament passages and will present oral reports.

Teaching, Preaching, Worship Seminar: (2 sem. hrs.) **Rev. Ryan K. Reynolds.** See credentials above.

Students will be supervised and evaluated in their teaching Bible lessons, leading worship and preaching.
