<u>The Pastor's Walk:</u> June 5 - 9 (1sem. hr.) Rev. Benjamin T. Parmer, Co-Vocational Minister, International Xchange Org.; M.Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; B.S. Business Management, Samford University; former Pastor Brookdale Presbyterian Church (EPC); former Dean of Students, Sangre de Cristo Seminary, Missionary to Puerto Rico, China and International Students; Campus Outreach Ministry, Univ. of Central Florida.

The Pastor's union to Jesus Christ, Glorying in His Cross, Fellowship with His Church and walking in the Spirit are foundational aspects of ministry. Without a focus on these principles a seminary education may be counterproductive.



Church Music: June 12 - 16 (1 sem. hr.) Rev. Jeff Pate, Pastor, Riverwood Presbyterian Church, Tuscaloosa, AL; M. Div. Sangre de Cristo Seminary; B.Ed. in Choral Music, Auburn University; Church Music Director; former Director of the Wet Mountain Valley Chorale.

A Biblical and historical study of music, and the pastor's responsibility for music in the worship ministry of the church.



<u>Doctrine of the Church</u>: June 19 - 23 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Luke Evans**, Lead Pastor, Christ Church San Antonio, TX; M.Div. Westminster Theological Seminary; B.A., Baylor University. *This course in ecclesiology is a systematic study of the Biblical teachings concerning the Church*.



<u>Apologetics</u>: June 26 - 30 (2 sem. hrs.) **Rev. Matthew Holst,** Instructor in Bible and Theology, Colorado Springs Christian School; M.Div., New Geneva Theological Seminary; M.A. in Historical Theology, Westminster Seminary, California. Pastor.

Students will be introduced to various world views and the discipline of defending the Christian Faith through Scripture.



<u>Church History III</u>: July 3 - 14 (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Anthony J. Felich,** Pastor, Redeemer PCA; D.Min., Th.M., Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary; D.Arts, Whitefield Theological Seminary; M.Div. Covenant Theological Seminary; B.A. Moody Bible Institute. School Pastor for Heritage Christian Academy, Chairman of Candidates and Credentials Committee of the Heartland Presbytery (PCA), and Board Member for Sangre De Cristo Seminary.

The history of the church will be studied from the Protestant Reformation to the Modern Church.

<u>Pastoral Duties I</u>: July 17 - 21 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. Anthony J. Felich,** See credentials above. The pastoral responsibilities such as weddings, funerals, and visitation, will be studied and practiced.



Pastoral Duties II: July 24 - 28 (1 sem. hr.) Rev. Philip S. Kruis, Pastor, Rincon Mountain Presbyterian Church, Tucson, AZ; Board Member, Providence College; M.Div. and Masters in Marriage and Family Therapy, Reformed Theological Seminary; B.A., Dordt College. The pastoral administrative responsibilities common to pastors in overseeing the office and business aspects of the local church will be introduced.

<u>Doctrine of the Sacraments</u>: July 31 – August 4 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Luke Evans,** See credentials above. *The Biblical and historical teaching of the meaning, means, and recipients of the sacraments will be studied.*

<u>Apologetics</u>: August 7 - 11 (2 sem. hrs.) **Rev. Matthew Holst,** See credentials above. *This is the second half of the course started June 26.*



<u>Biblical Ethics</u>: August 14 - 25 (2 sem. hrs.) **Rev. Randy C. Martin,** Executive Director, Ambassador Presbyterian Church, Apex, NC, and Instructor at Veritas Scholars Academy; M.Div., Covenant Theological Seminary; B.A. UCLA; Former Pastor, Covenant Presbyterian Church, (PCA) Bakersfield, CA; Former Instructor at Bakersfield Christian High School (CA); Apologist and Writer. *A study of the Biblical standards for personal and social behavior*

<u>Doctrine of Salvation</u>: August 28 – September 1 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. Tony Felich,** See credentials above. Students will study Soteriology to deepen their understanding of the finished and ongoing work of Christ.



Epistle to the Colossians: June 6 - August 29 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. D. James Johnson,** Vice President, Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D.Min., New Geneva Theological Seminary; M.Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; M.B.A., University of Phoenix; B.S., University of Florida; Ruling Elder, Village Seven Presbyterian Church; former Pastor, Christian Camp Director, Christian School/Seminary Instructor and Administrator.

This is a weekly exegetical study of Colossians with a focus on the epistle's purpose and development with application for today.



<u>Public Worship:</u> June 7 – August 30 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller,** President, Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D.Min., Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary; Th.M. Covenant Theological Seminary; M.Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; B.A. Covenant College; CPE Advanced Status; Pastor, Army Reserve Chaplain (COL) Ret.

This course exposes the student to different models of worship practiced by the summer instructors.

Fall Semester Schedule - 2023

September 11 – December 15

Essentials of New Testament Greek: (10 sem. hrs.) Dr. D. James Johnson, See credentials above. Students will learn the basics of New Testament Greek grammar and syntax and begin to translate and study the New Testament from the Greek.

<u>New Testament Survey</u>: (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller,** See credentials above. *In this course students will read the whole New Testament and will cover the background, themes, development, and purposes of each book.*

<u>Applied Exegesis</u>: (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller,** See credentials above. This course trains the students to follow a logical process in preparing sermons and Bible lessons. This was formerly called The Exegetical, Hermeneutical, Homiletical Process.

<u>Greek Exegesis and Seminar</u>: (2 sem. hrs. each) Prerequisite: N.T. Greek; **Dr. D. James Johnson**, See credentials above.

Detailed studies of New Testament passages will be made from New Testament Greek texts. In the Seminar, Seniors will prepare and teach sections of New Testament passages and oral reports.



<u>Hebrew Exegesis and Seminar</u>: (2 sem. hrs. each) Prerequisite: O.T. Hebrew; **Dr. Dwight F. Zeller**, Director Emeritus, Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D.Min., Eastern Baptist Theological Seminary; Th.M., Chicago Graduate School of Theology; M.Div., Memphis Theological Seminary; B.A., Bob Jones University; Pastor and Retired Navy Chaplain.

Detailed studies of Old Testament passages will be made from Old Testament Hebrew texts. In this Seminar, Seniors will prepare and teach sections of New and Old Testament passages and will present oral reports.

<u>Teaching, Preaching, Worship Seminar</u>: (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller,** See credentials above. Students will be supervised and evaluated in their teaching Bible lessons, leading worship and preaching.
