**ST412 Doctrine of Biblical Inspiration:** June 3 - 7 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Randy C. Martin**, Executive Director, Ambassador Presbyterian Church, Apex, NC, and Instructor at Veritas Scholars Academy; M.Div., Covenant Theological Seminary; B.A. UCLA; Former Pastor, Covenant Presbyterian Church, (PCA) Bakersfield, CA; Former Instructor at Bakersfield Christian High School (CA); Apologist and Writer.

*This is an exposition of the doctrine of the Scriptures with special attention given to divine inspiration and Biblical inerrancy.*

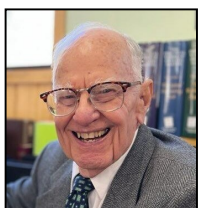
**ST421 Doctrine of Man:** June 10 - 14 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Randy C. Martin**, See credentials above.

*This is a systematic study of man's origin as a covenant creature and covenant breaker, his need of salvation, his redemptive state and future glorification.*



**BT361 Old Testament Theology:** June 17 - 28 (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Daniel K. Chinn**, Associate Professor of Biblical and Theological Studies, College of the Ozarks; D. Min., Covenant Theological Seminary; M. Div., Westminster Theological Seminary; B.A., Oklahoma Wesleyan University; Church Planter.

*This is a progressive study of theology as it is presented in the Old Testament with a focus on God's Covenants.*



**BT341 New Testament Introduction, part 1:** July 1 - 5 (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Dwight F. Zeller**, Director Emeritus, Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D. Min., Eastern Baptist Theological Seminary; Th. M. Chicago Graduate School of Theology; M. Div., Memphis Theological Seminary; B. A., Bob Jones University. Pastor and Navy Chaplain (CDR) Ret.

*This course considers the background and setting of the New Testament along with its transmission, manuscripts, canonicity and translation.*



**HT712 Church History I:** July 8 - 19 (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Tony Felich**, Senior Pastor, Redeemer Presbyterian Church (PCA), Overland Park, KS; D. Min. Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary; D. Arts, Whitefield Theological Seminary; Th.M., Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary; M. Div. Covenant Theological Seminary; B.A., Moody Bible Institute.

*In this course the history of the church will be studied from New Testament times to the Sixth Century.*



**PT861 Missions:** July 22 - 26 (1 sem. hr.); **Rev. Benjamin T. Parmer**, Co-Vocational Minister, International Xchange Org.; M.Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; B.S. Business Management, Samford University; former Pastor Brookdale Presbyterian Church (EPC); former Dean of Students, Sangre de Cristo Seminary, Missionary to Puerto Rico, China and International Students; Campus Outreach Ministry, Univ. of Central Florida.

*This course will consider the purpose, philosophy, methods, and history of Christian missions.*



**PT851 Pastoral Counseling:** July 29 – Aug 9 (2 sem. hrs.) [Co-taught by Ron & Zach Kruis]

**Rev. Ron Kruis**, Mental Health Therapist, Montrose Public Schools; Ruling Elder, Trinity Reformed Presbyterian Church, Montrose, Colorado; M. Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; M.A., New Mexico State University; B.A., Dordt College. Pastor.



**Rev. Zach Kruis**, Pastor, Trinity Reformed Church (PCA), New Castle, CO; M. Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D. Min. Candidate, Birmingham Theological Seminary, Biblical Counseling.

*This course is an introduction to providing pastoral counseling in light of Biblical principles.*



**ST413 Doctrine of God:** August 12 – 16 (1 sem. hr.) **Rev. Nigel Agnew**, currently serves as Pastor of the Riverside Church in Newry, Ireland and has served elsewhere in the Reformed Presbyterian Church since 1997. Reformed Presbyterian Theological College in Belfast, Diploma in Theology; Queen's University, LLB (Law and Accounting), Post Graduate Certificate in Legal Studies. He has taught Old Testament History at Belfast Bible College and has practiced as a lawyer.

*An examination of theology proper, God's nature, existence, attributes, decrees, creation, and providence will be presented.*



**ST614 Comparative Biblical Theologies:** Aug 19 - 23 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. Dominic A. Aquilla**, President and Professor of Pastoral Ministry, New Geneva Theological Seminary; D. Min., Westminster Theological Seminary; M.Div., Reformed Theological Seminary; B.A., Belhaven College. A prominent leader in the PCA; Pastor.

*This course will compare the differences between various contemporary Biblical issues such as theonomy, dispensationalism, covenantalism, views of creation and the charismatic movement.*

**BT386 Book of Ephesians:** June 4 – Aug 27 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. D. James Johnson**, President, Sangre de Cristo Seminary; D.Min., New Geneva Theological Seminary; M.Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; M.B.A., University of Phoenix; B.S., University of Florida; Ruling Elder Emeritus, Village Seven Presbyterian Church; former Classical Christian School Superintendent, Pastor, Christian Camp Director.

*This is a weekly exegetical study of Paul's Epistle to the Ephesians with application for today.*



**PT811 Public Worship:** June 5 - August 28 (1 sem. hr.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller**, Pastor, Sangre de Cristo Seminary Chapel; D. Min., Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary; Th.M. Covenant Theological Seminary; M.Div., Sangre de Cristo Seminary; B.A. Covenant College; CPE Advanced Status; Pastor, Army Reserve Chaplain (COL) Ret.

*This is a time of sincere worship followed by a discussion. The students are exposed to different models of worship practiced by the instructors.*

### Fall Semester Schedule – 2024 - September 9 – December 13

**ET112 Essentials of Old Testament Hebrew:** (10 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller**, See credentials above.

*Students will learn the basics of Old Testament Hebrew grammar and syntax and begin to translate and study the Old Testament from the Hebrew.*

**BT311 Old Testament Survey I: Pentateuch and Historical Books:** (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. D. James Johnson**, See credentials above. *This course will cover the background, development and purpose of the Books from Genesis through II Samuel.*

**ET622 Hermeneutics:** (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller**, See credentials above.

*This course explores the principles of Biblical interpretation and how these principles are used.*

**PT812 Teaching, Preaching, Worship Seminar:** (2 sem. hrs.) **Dr. Andrew S. Zeller**, See credentials above.

*Students will be supervised and evaluated in teaching Bible lessons, leading worship and preaching.*

**ET232 Greek Exegesis I and ET292 Greek Seminar:** (2 sem. hrs. each) Prerequisite: N.T. Greek. **Dr. D. James Johnson**, See credentials above.

*Detailed studies of New Testament passages will be made from the Greek Text. Seniors will prepare and teach sections of New Testament passages and will give written and oral exegetical reports.*

**ET142 Hebrew Exegesis II and ET192 Hebrew Seminar:** (2 sem. hrs. each) Prerequisite: O.T. Hebrew. **Dr. Dwight F. Zeller**, See credentials above.
